

Hurricane Bulletin

The City of Crisfield along with Somerset County, the State of Maryland and other emergency agencies are closely monitoring the movement of the impending Storm Hurricane Sandy.

It is presently forecast to hit our area on Sunday with flooding and heavy rains predicted for approximately three days. People living in low lying areas that regularly flood need to be prepared to evacuate if the flooding becomes severe.

Parking of vehicles at Carvel Hall, in designated areas only, will be permitted beginning Saturday, October 27th.

Garbage collection for City residents will be deferred until Wednesday and Thursday, October 31st and November 1st.

Once a state of emergency is called by the State of Maryland, and flood conditions warrant evacuation, buses will be available at Crisfield High School to transport flood victims to a shelter at Washington High School. Closely watch WBOC and WMDT TV for further announcements. Regular emergencies will continue to call "911".
