ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2019, AT 5:00 P.M., THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRISFIELD WILL HOLD A WORK SESSION IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE STRATTON-CORBIN LIBRARY, LOCATED AT 4 EAST MAIN STREET, CRISFIELD, MARYLAND 21817. THE PURPOSE OF THIS WORK SESSION, AND THE ONLY ITEMS OF BUSINESS ON THE AGENDA, ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. DISCUSSION BETWEEN THE MAYOR, THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITY OFFICIALS REGARDING THE PROVISIONS OF AN ORDINANCE, PASSED BY VOTE OF THE CITY COUNCIL ON FIRST READER AT THE SEPTEMBER 25, 2019 REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, ADDING A NEW ARTICLE II TO CHAPTER 84 OF THE CRISFIELD CITY CODE, TITLED “VACANT AND BLIGHTED BUILDING REGISTRATION”, TO ESTABLISH NEW LAWS CREATING A REGISTRATION PROGRAM FOR VACANT AND BLIGHTED BUILDINGS LOCATED WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CRISFIELD.

THE WORK SESSION WILL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND THE PUBLIC IS INVITED TO ATTEND. PLEASE NOTE: DUE TO THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEETING THAT BEGINS AT 6:00 P.M. IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE WORK SESSION, TIME FOR PUBLIC COMMENT DURING THE WORK SESSION MAY BE LIMITED OR UNAVAILABLE. PUBLIC COMMENT WILL, HOWEVER, BE CONSIDERED DURING THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEETING THAT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWS THIS WORK SESSION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGENDA FOR THAT MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEETING.

AT ALL TIMES, DURING THIS WORK SESSION, THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CONVENE IN CLOSED SESSION FOR ANY PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY THE PROVISIONS OF MD CODE, GENERAL PROVISIONS, § 3-305.
