Public Hearing for an Ordinance Amending Chapter 84 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, to Add a New Article II, Titled “Vacant and Blighted Building Registration”, Which Shall Be Codified at Section 84-4 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Crisfield will hold a Public Hearing for the Second and Final Reading of an Ordinance amending Chapter 84 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, titled “Permits and Licenses”, by adding a new Article II thereto titled “Vacant and Blighted Building Registration”, which shall be codified at Section 84-4, *et seq.* The purpose of the Ordinance is to establish laws authorizing a new program, to be administered by the City of Crisfield, intended to register vacant and blighted buildings located within the municipal limits of the City of Crisfield, as more particularly set forth in the Ordinance.

The Mayor and City Council will hold the Public Hearing on Wednesday, October 9, 2019 during the regularly scheduled Mayor and City Council Meeting commencing at 6:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of the Stratton-Corbin Library. The Public Hearing will be held at approximately 6:25 p.m. during the Open Session portion of the Mayor and City Council Meeting, immediately prior to the aforesaid Ordinance being called for a vote on Second Reading. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear opponents and proponents of the proposed Ordinance, if there be any, and citizens are invited to testify at the Public Hearing.
