**Public Hearing for an Ordinance Amending Chapter 91 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code,
Titled “RESIDENTIAL RENTAL HOUSING LICENSE AND INSPECTION”**

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Crisfield will hold a Public Hearing for the second and final reading of an Ordinance amending Chapter 91 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, entitled “Residential Rental Housing License and Inspection”. The Ordinance amends Chapter 91 for the purpose of establishing that the provisions set forth therein shall apply to all residential dwelling units which are owned by the Crisfield Housing Authority and rented to participants of the public housing program administered and operated by the Crisfield Housing Authority as authorized by the provisions of MD Code, Housing & Community Development, § 12-101, et seq.

The Mayor and City Council will hold the Public Hearing on Wednesday, January 8, 2020 during the regularly scheduled Mayor and City Council Meeting commencing at 6:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of the Stratton-Corbin Library. The Public Hearing will be held at approximately 6:05 p.m. during the Open Session portion of the Mayor and City Council Meeting and immediately preceding the Ordinance being called for a vote on Second Reader. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear opponents and proponents of the proposed Ordinance, if there be any, and citizens are invited to testify at the Public Hearing.
