Public Hearing for an Ordinance Repealing Section 45-5 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, Titled “REGISTRATION OF RENTAL UNITS”, and Adopting a New Chapter 91 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, Titled “RESIDENTIAL RENTAL HOUSING LICENSE AND INSPECTION”

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor and Council of the City of Crisfield will hold a Public Hearing for the second and final reading of an Ordinance repealing Section 45-5 (“REGISTRATION OF RENTAL UNITS”) of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code and adopting a new Chapter 91 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, titled “RESIDENTIAL RENTAL HOUSING LICENSE AND INSPECTION”. The Ordinance is intended to establish a new licensing and inspection program for residential rental dwelling units within the City of Crisfield, as more particularly set forth therein.

The Mayor and Council will hold the Public Hearing on Wednesday, October 10, 2018 during the regularly scheduled Mayor and Council meeting, commencing at 6:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of City Hall. The Public Hearing will be held during the Open Session portion of the Mayor and Council meeting, at approximately 6:15 p.m. and immediately prior to the aforesaid Ordinance being called for second and final reading. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear opponents and proponents of the proposed Ordinance, if there be any, and citizens are invited to testify at the Public Hearing.

A copy of the proposed Ordinance, which repeals Section 45-5 (“REGISTRATION OF RENTAL UNITS”) of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code and adopts a new Chapter 91 of the City of Crisfield Municipal Code, titled “RESIDENTIAL RENTAL HOUSING LICENSE AND INSPECTION”, may be examined at City Hall during regular business hours.
