## **Public Hearing on Ordinance Amending Section 112-20, Section 112-56 and Article IX of the Crisfield City Code**

In accordance with Section 112-15(C) of the Crisfield City Code, notice is hereby given that the Mayor and Council of the City of Crisfield will hold a Public Hearing regarding an Ordinance amending Chapter 112 (Zoning) of the Crisfield City Code as follows:

- Amending Section 112-20 of the Crisfield City Code, entitled “Definition of terms”, for the purpose of adding certain defined terms in connection with the amendments to Article IX of Chapter 112 of the Crisfield City Code permitting the operation of campgrounds on property zoned “TM Tourist-Maritime District” subject to those supplemental use regulations set forth in the Ordinance;
- Amending Section 112-56 of the Crisfield City Code, entitled “Table of Permitted Uses”, for the purpose of establishing “Campgrounds” may be permitted on property zoned “TM Tourist-Maritime District” subject to the approval of the City of Crisfield Board Zoning Appeals granting a special exception for such use; and,
- Amending Article IX of Chapter 112 of the Crisfield City Code to add a new Section 112-71.1, entitled “Campgrounds”, for the purpose of establishing standards governing approval by the City of Crisfield Board Zoning Appeals to permit campgrounds on property zoned “TM Tourist-Maritime District” by special exception.

The Mayor and City Council will hold the Public Hearing on Wednesday, December 11, 2019 during the regularly scheduled Mayor and City Council Meeting commencing at 6:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of the Stratton-Corbin Library. The Public Hearing will be held at approximately 6:20 p.m. during the Open Session portion of the Mayor and City Council Meeting, immediately prior to the aforesaid Ordinance being called for a vote on Second Reader. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear opponents and proponents of the proposed Ordinance, if there be any, and citizens are invited to testify at the Public Hearing.

Written comments regarding the proposed Ordinance may be submitted to City Hall, c/o Valerie Swift, in advance of the Public Hearing, and questions in advance of the Public Hearing may be directed to Valerie Swift at (410) 968-1333. A copy of the Ordinance, which is the subject of the Public Hearing, may be examined at City Hall during regular business hours.
