**Public Hearing on Ordinance Amending Sections 112-55, 112-56 and 112-57
of the Crisfield City Code**

In accordance with Section 112-15(C) of the Crisfield City Code, notice is hereby given that the Mayor and Council of the City of Crisfield will hold a Public Hearing regarding an Ordinance amending Chapter 112 (Zoning) of the Crisfield City Code as follows:


- Amending Section 112-55 of the Crisfield City Code, entitled "Use of the Designations P, PC, SE and SC in the Table of Permissible Uses", to correct a drafting error;
- Amending Section 112-56 of the Crisfield City Code, entitled, "Table of Permitted Uses", for the purpose of permitting "Accessory Dwellings" on property zoned "C-1 Neighborhood Commercial District"; and,
- Amending Section 112-57 of the Crisfield City Code, entitled "Accessory Dwelling Units", for the purpose of establishing supplemental use regulations for "Accessory Dwellings" located on property zoned "C-1 Neighborhood Commercial District".

The Mayor and Council will hold the Public Hearing on Wednesday, March 13, 2019, during the regularly scheduled Mayor and Council meeting commencing at 6:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of City Hall. The Public Hearing will be held during the Open Session portion of the Mayor and Council meeting, at approximately 6:15 p.m., and immediately prior to Second Reading of the Ordinance amending Chapter 112 (Zoning) of the Crisfield City Code as set forth above. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear opponents and proponents of the amendments set forth in the Ordinance, if there be any, and citizens are invited to testify at the Public Hearing.

Written comments regarding the above-described Ordinance may be submitted to City Hall, c/o Valerie Swift, in advance of the Public Hearing, and questions relating to the Public Hearing may be directed to Ms. Swift at (410) 968-1333. A copy of the Ordinance, which is the subject of the Public Hearing, may be examined at City Hall during regular business hours.
