

CITY OF CRISFIELD ANNOUNCES ACTIONS TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH, LIMIT SPREAD OF COVID-19

The Mayor of the City of Crisfield has announced a series of actions to protect the public health and limit the spread of COVID-19 in Crisfield, Maryland.

City hall has restricted access to City Hall for essential employees only, payments may be made via the back-door drop. Cash payments may be made by calling ahead 410-968-1333, option 1, and the employee will wait for the customer to acknowledge receipt. Water disconnects will be delayed, and late fees waived.

Corbin Studio & Gallery, 4 E. Main St. restricted access for essential personnel only.

The Crisfield Police Department will have the front door open for entrance during regular business hours. The dispatch is on duty to speak to through a window and intercom. Only essential personnel will be admitted into the officer's area.

Rental registrations have been suspended until State of Emergency is cancelled.

March 25, 2020 Mayor & Council meeting is cancelled.

Passive Park/Nature trail ribbon cutting scheduled for March 20, 2020 has been postponed.

City employees who have COVID-19 related symptoms are asked to stay home. Call in procedures are still in place.

Please check on your elderly neighbors and friends to be sure, they are safe, have food and medications. Phone calls would be the safest approach.

Sewer safety!! Please do **NOT** flush paper towels, baby wipes, cleaning wipes or any item that is **NOT** biodegradable. FYI, most wipes say flushable, but that is not the same. This type of material continually clog the pump stations that process the sewer, resulting in back-ups.

We ask that you make yourself aware of the Governor's latest restrictions and closings.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. These measures are designed to keep the citizens of the City of Crisfield healthy and to assist in preventing the spread of the virus.
